All KRCA Certified Contractors must complete ten credits of continuing education a year to remain certified. KRCA's commitment to education ensures that all members stay ahead of the curve with new industry products and procedures.

Furnishing Quality Materials

A KRCA certified roofing professional knows the best choice for roofing materials when considering budgets and roofing needs. All KRCA members have ongoing relationships with reputable manufacturers who can provide durable, reliable, quality materials.

Insured

All KRCA certified professionals must have, at the minimum, a \$1,000,000 liability insurance policy and be bonded. A qualified roofing contractor knows the dangers of their profession and the property value at hand. Being properly insured is a must for any professional roofing contractor.

Committed to Safety

KRCA encourages safe working environments and provides formal safety training programs to all of its members.

- Not enter knowingly into any contract, the terms of which may imperil the rights of either labor or the suppliers of material to receive a fair return for services or goods furnished.
- Not misrepresent purposely themselves, company, or any warranties, nor will the KRCA member otherwise knowingly engage in any type of fraud.
- Comply in spirit with all rules and regulations prescribed by law for the health and safety of the community and environment.
- Not perform, or caused to be performed, any act which would tend to reflect negatively on, or bring into disrepute, any legitimate part of the roofing industry.
- Fairly convey and honestly explain any and all proposed or executed roofing warranties.
